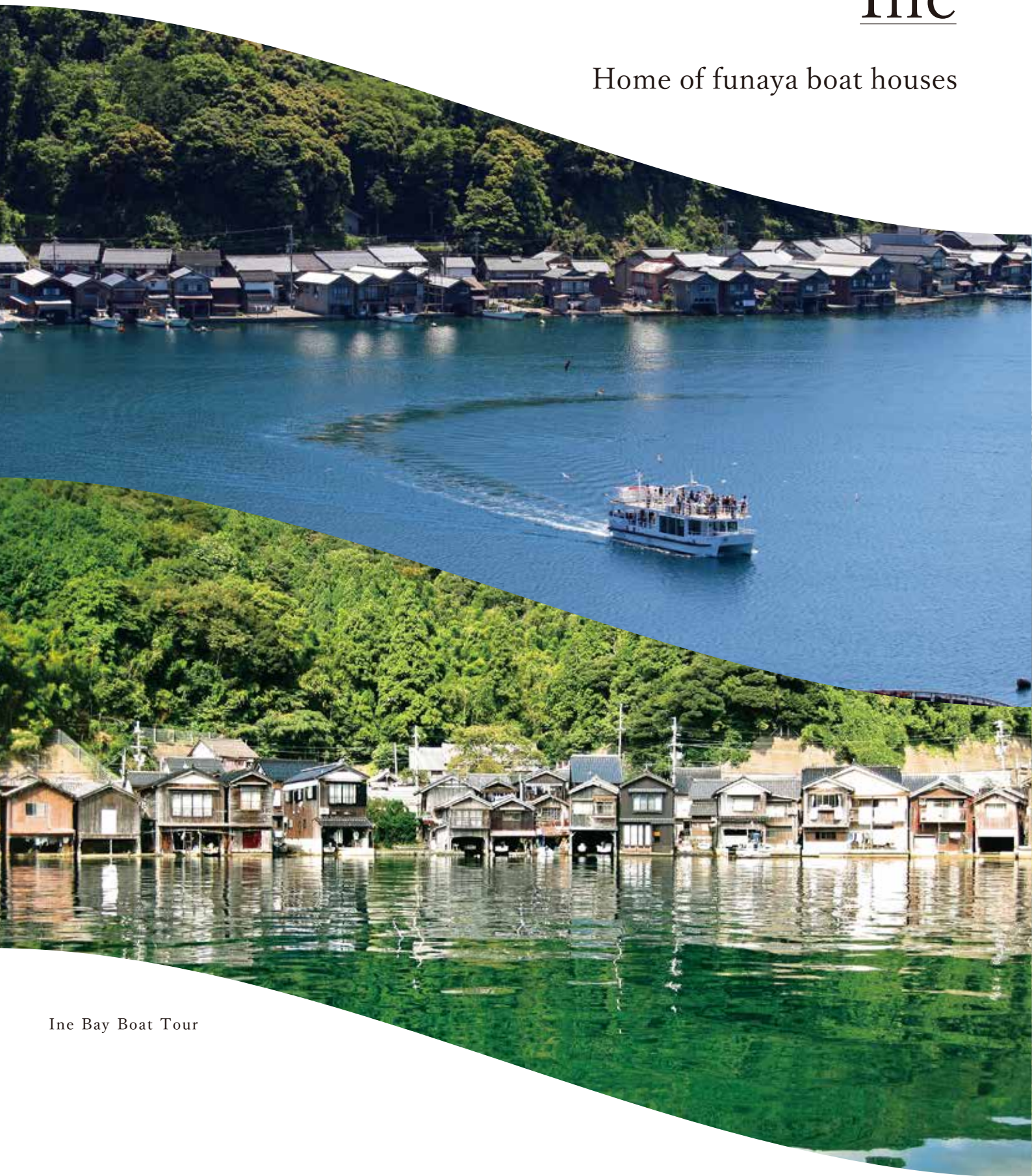

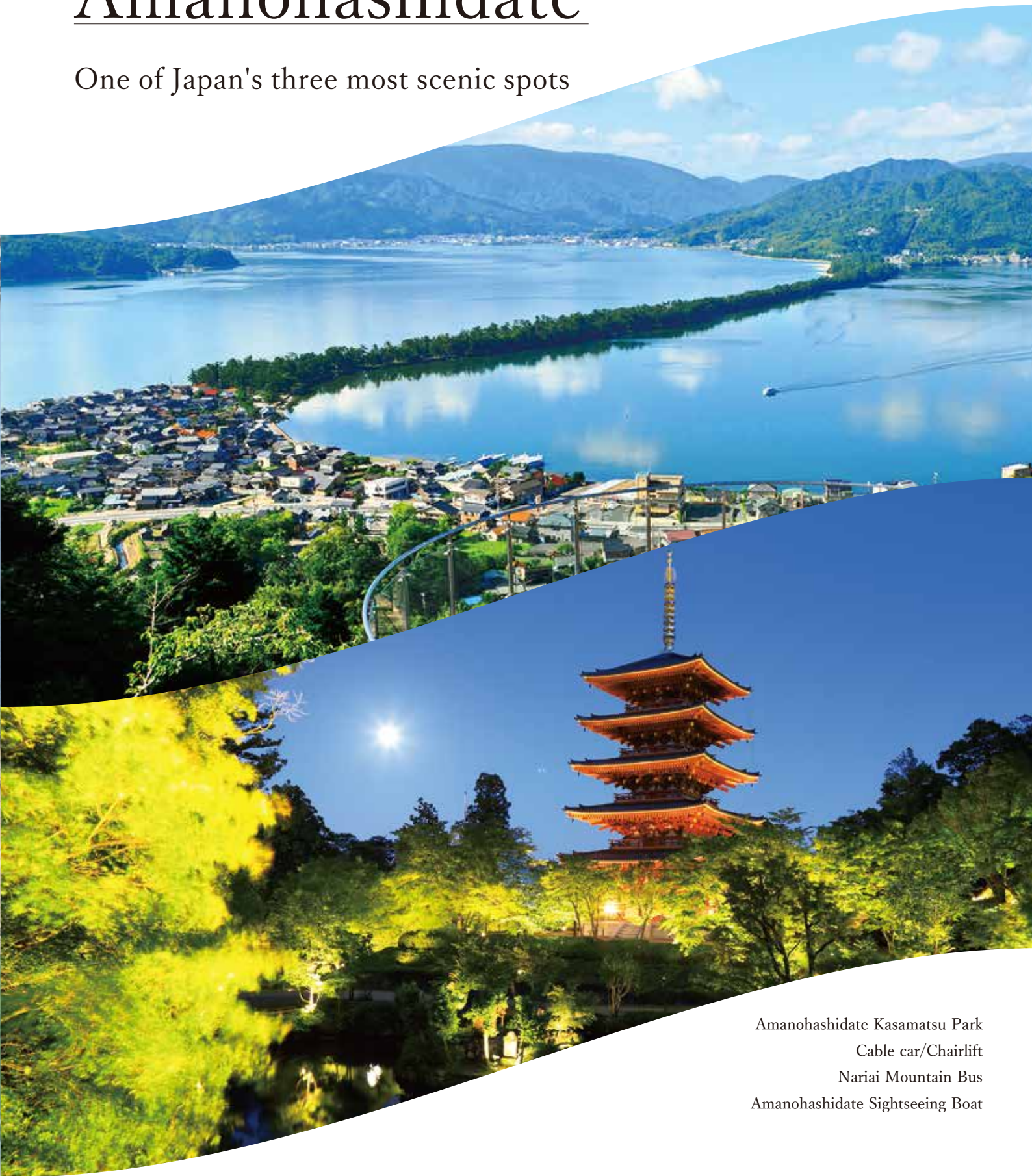

Visit Nariai-ji Temple!

Temple no. 28 on the Saigoku Kannon Pilgrimage route, Nariai-ji Temple has attracted the faithful since ancient times. It's even mentioned in the Konjaku Monogatari from the Heian period (794-1185). Known as a temple where prayers are answered, its Kannon statue continues to hear many people's prayers even today.



Nariai Mountain Bus

Visit Amanohashidate Kasamatsu Park!

A favorite spot of writers and artists, Amanohashidate Kasamatsu Park is where the practice of "matanozoki" (bending over while facing away from the sea, to view the scenery from between your legs) originated. By reversing the positions of sky and sea, "matanozoki" makes pine-lined Amanohashidate sandbar look like a bridge to heaven. Here you can also catch a glimpse of the heavens as depicted in fairy tales.



Amanohashidate Cable car/Chairlift

- Roundtrip fare : adult 800 yen, child 400 yen
- Time : approx. 4 min. by cable car, approx. 7 min. by chairlift

Ride an Amanohashidate Sightseeing Boat!

This 12 min. voyage along pine-lined Amanohashidate sandbar includes an opportunity to feed the seagulls. Enjoy a smooth ride on the tranquil inland sea waters.



Amanohashidate Sightseeing Boat

- Main route : Amanohashidate boat dock - Ichinomiya boat dock
- One-way fare : adult 800 yen, child 400 yen
- Roundtrip fare : adult 1,300 yen, child 650 yen
- Time : approx. 12 min. (One-way)

Amanohashidate Sightseeing Boat & Rental Bicycle

- Depart: by Rental Bicycle
- Return: by Sightseeing Boat

Ine is a waterfront town where fishing is an integral part of community life. The unique sight of more than 200 funaya homes with boathouses seemingly floating on the side of the bay has earned the town recognition as a historic buildings preservation district by the Japanese government. Enjoy the atmospheric view of funaya from the sea on a sightseeing boat.



Ine Bay Boat Tour

- Fare : adult 1,200 yen, child 600 yen
- Time : approx. 25 min.
- Hours : 9:00 am - 4:00 pm (boats leave on every 30 min.)
